



Routine & Seasonal Checklist

RV Interior & Exterior Cleaning

RV Interior

- Unplug Appliances
- Remove & Dispose of Food from Refrigerator and Cabinetry
- Use Mild Soap/Spray on Countertops and Hardware
- Pour Mild Vinegar Solution Down Sink, Shower, & Toilet to Contain Odor
- Spray Down all Glass and Mirrors
- Use Mild Soap/Spray on Paneling
- Wipe Down Paneling, Tables, Countertops, & Appliances with Soft Cloth or Soft Sponge
- Make Sure There's No Grease Spots in Appliances
- Furniture Upholstery Should be Spot Cleaned or Professionally Cleaned
- Vacuum or Dust with Soft Brush All Window Treatments and Blinds
- Remove & Wash all Linens and Towels
- Wipe down Ceilings & Walls with Damp Cloth
- Remove & Rinse Screens and Vents
- Remove and Clean A/C Filter or Post a Note to Replace for Next Season
- Finish with Wet/Dry Mopping & Floor Vacuuming

RV Exterior

- Start by Parking in Shade
- Gentle Spray Down Paneling with Water from Top to Bottom
- Use Mild Car Soap to Wash from Top to Bottom
- Use Caution when Using Pressure Spray Nozzles
- Inspect Roof for Damage
- Wash Undercarriage
- Use Cloth or Sponge on Rubber Window & Door Seals
- Turn off Propane Gas Lines & Put Tank in Storage
- Clean & Check Brake Lights and Motorhome Headlights
- Check & Change Motorhome Fluids and Filters
- Wash & Wipe Down Windows
- Lubricate RV Slideouts & Awnings (Check for Damages)
- Check Paint for Touch-ups
- Finish Paneling with Gentle Wax (Never in Sunlight)
- Examine, Scrub, & Shine Your Tires
